'THE FACE BEHIND THE FEATHER' RELEASES ALBUM



Berkshire based singer-songwriter Ginni, **the face behind the feather**, has released her eclectic rock/pop **album entitled 'GINNI'**, which features her emotive **single 'Jump The Sky'**. This innovative writer and performer is creating a buzz with interviews on regional **BBC Radio**, **BBC Online**, **Blast 386FM**, **2-Ten FM**, **Star 106.6FM** and the local **Observer** newspaper.

'Jump the Sky' was **selected by the BPI** (British Phonographic Industry), who are responsible for the Brit Awards, to **appear on their 'British at MIDEM' sampler CD**. 'Jump the Sky' was featured alongside some of the best current British talent, such as Nizlope, the Delays and Goldie Lookin' Chain. The British at MIDEM CD was handed out at the World largest International Music Industry event, MIDEM held in Cannes this January.

Ginni, a previous **BBC song contest winner** filmed an artistic video, which compliments the imagery of the lyrics in 'Jump the Sky'. This video can be seen on the video walls in **Toni and Guy Salons, Health Clubs such as Fitness First and Lloyds Bars and Pubs** across the country (about 400 in total).

Producer James Hallawell, engaged on behalf of **Stephen Budd Management**, describes Ginni as **"A great writer with a lot of depth"** and refers to the album as **"Thought Provoking"**.

Her fan base is growing both in the UK and abroad, and in her adopted hometown of Windsor, her fans affectionately describe her as a "sexy earth mother with a blissful voice and great songs".

Further to a successful career in Musical Theatre, gaining her National Newspaper and TV coverage in South Africa, Ginni moved to the UK to pursue her dream of becoming a singer, songwriter, pianist and guitarist.

Since then Ginni has performed at various music venues around the UK, as well as in Amsterdam, California and South Africa. Her debut solo album 'Between These Walls', was released in June 2001 and she toured the UK solo and with her band.

Ginni and Madam Music are delighted with the GINNI album, which was recorded at London's Westside Studios, using the same mixing console as used for 'Dark Side of the Moon'.
